



**A SURVEY OF ADULTS  
IN  
NEW YORK CITY AND LONG ISLAND**

**February 5-9, 2020**

## METHODS

The following topline and crosstabs contain data from a poll of 600 adults in New York City and Long Island. The poll was conducted from February 5-9, 2020 via landline and cell phone. Findings applying to the 600 sample are subject to sampling error of plus or minus 3.9%. Subgroups of the sample are subject to error of up to plus or minus 10%.

The following definitions describe subgroups used in the crosstabs. Percentages in parentheses refer to each subgroup's proportion of the total sample. Question numbers from which the subgroups are derived are also included.

### CROSTAB KEY

- **REGION** *New York City* (75%) includes respondents who live in one of the five boroughs of New York City – the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, or Staten Island. *Long Island* (25%) includes respondents who live in Nassau County or Suffolk County (Q.2).
- **RACE** *White* (48%) includes respondents who are white or multi-racial, including white. *Black* (19%) includes respondents who are black/African American or multi-racial, including black/African American. *Hispanic* (22%) includes respondents who are of Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish origin, or who volunteer Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish as their race, or are multi-racial, including Latino, Hispanic, or Spanish. *Other* (13%) includes respondents who are American Indian, Asian, or of some other race or are multi-racial, including American Indian, Asian, or another race (Q.19, Q.20).
- **CONCERN ABOUT CORONAVIRUS** *Low (1-3)* (16%) includes respondents who rate their overall concern about Coronavirus a 1, 2, or 3, on a scale of 1 to 10, where 1 means not concerned at all and 10 means extremely concerned. *Medium (4-6)* (22%) includes respondents who rate their concern a 4, 5, or 6. *High (7-9)* (28%) includes respondents who rate their concern a 7, 8, or 9. *Very high (10)* (34%) includes respondents who rate their concern a 10 (Q.4).
- **FLU SHOT** *Yes* (75%) includes respondents who received a flu shot since September of 2019. *No* (24%) includes respondents who have not received a flu shot since September of 2019 (Q.14).
- **GENDER** *Men* (48%) includes male respondents. *Women* (52%) includes female respondents (Q.21).

- **AGE** 18-34 (16%) includes respondents age 18-34. 35-49 (28%) includes respondents age 35-49. 50-64 (29%) includes respondents age 50 to 64. 65+ (26%) includes respondents age 65 and older (Q.18).
- **GENDER/AGE** *Men under 50* (24%) includes male respondents under age 50. *Men 50+* (24%) includes male respondents age 50 and over. *Women under 50* (21%) includes female respondents under age 50. *Women 50+* (31%) includes female respondents age 50 and over (Q.18, Q.21).
